South Downs College 14-16 School Links Programme is a part time provision that aims to bridge the gap between school and vocational education. Programmes focus on specific vocational areas and most of the qualifications offered are recognised within the Key Stage 4 League Tables. We work closely with both mainstream and special schools to offer a captivating, enjoyable and inventive variety for students to choose from.



This will provide an introduction to some of the key themes within the animal care industry, enabling students to develop their knowledge and practical skills needed to care for small animals. Students will check the health, learn how to care, recognise what accommodation is required, catching and restraining, grooming, feeding and the moving and handling of them.

Please note that students will be required to have an up to date tetanus before starting on this course.

Progression: starting College on a full time programme or apprenticeship within the animal care industry.

HAIRDRESSING AND AUTY THERAPY

VTCT Level 2 Certificate in Hairdressing & Beauty Therapy (VRQ)

Students will gain a broad understanding of the hair and beauty sector, including skills in business enterprise, hair and beauty science, marketing and promotion and a hair and beauty research and design project.

Progression: onto a full time course in Hairdressing or Beauty Therapy or onto an Apprenticeship in this important and potentially lucrative industry.



NCFE Level 1 / 2 Award in Creative Craft (Cookery)

This qualification provides an introduction to some of the key resources and ideas within catering and hospitality, the use of materials, tools and equipment and the preparation and presentation of cookery items. There is also the option for working towards a Practical Cookery Skills College Certificate.

Progression: onto a full time catering course or an Apprenticeship within the hospitality industry, which is a key part of the local economy.

FNGINEERING AND MOTOR VEHICLE



City & Guilds 3902 Entry Level 3 in Vehicle Systems Maintenance (2 Year course) ABC Level 1 Award in Motor Vehicle Studies (1 Year course)

For Year 10 students we recommend that they are enrolled onto the City & Guilds qualification as this will cover their 2 years at College. They will study 6 units per year, comprising of Vehicle Engine Systems, Lubrication Systems and Vehicle Electrical Systems amongst others. The students will learn through practical sessions and assignments.

For Year 11 students starting their first year at College, we recommend the one year course offered by ABC which covers units comprising of Compression Ignition Power Units, Spark Ignition Power Units, Vehicle Transmission and Steering & Suspension.

Progression: enrolling onto one of the Motor Vehicle or Engineering courses available at College or an Apprenticeship.





The Sport and Leisure qualification is tailored towards participation in a wide range of sports, with learners taking part in exercise and fitness testing, planning an improvement programme, developing knowledge about how the body works and learning about work in the sport and leisure industry.

Progression: students could enrol onto a full time Sport and Leisure course at College or an Apprenticeship in this growing industry.



Pearson Edexcel Level 1 Certificate in Digital Applications (CiDA)

This qualification is ideal for anyone with a keen interest to develop their skills for the IT and Digital industry including the Gaming market. Topics covered are Game Making, Creative Multimedia, Artwork and Imaging, Developing Web Products and Coding for the Web.

Progression: moving onto a full time ICT or Digital Media course at College or Apprenticeship within the industry.

Programmes run for 33 weeks (Year 1) and 28 weeks (Year 2) with 4 hours of contact time in College per week.
