## **Entering the Competition**

- 1. The Film Competition (the "Competition") is open to UK residents, who are enrolled as a student at a UK school and have applied for a place at a UK tertiary institution in Autumn 2017.
- 2. Employees or agencies of Havant College or South Downs College or their family members, or anyone else connected with the Competition, may not enter the Competition.
- 3. By entering the Competition you ("You") are accepting these terms and conditions.
- 4. You are responsible for the cost (if any) of creating your Competition entry and sending it to us, as well as all other costs associated with participation in the Competition. You must pay all other costs associated with the prize and not specifically included in the prize.
- 5. Only one entry is permitted per person/pair.
- 6. The Competition commences at 9am on 15 March 2017 and closes at 11.59pm on 21 April 2017. Entries received after that date and time will not be considered. The promoters reserve the right in their absolute discretion to extend the closing date for a reasonable period of time where an insufficient number of the entries received have satisfied the entry and judging criteria
- 7. You own the copyright to your Competition entry as its author.
- 8. By submitting an entry to the Competition, you give the promoters:
- a. Permission for your entry to be published on havant.ac.uk and southdowns.ac.uk and grant the promoters (Havant College and South Downs College) a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to use and publish your Competition entry in electronic format (including on the promoters' websites) and hard copy (including in the promoters' publications), both as a full video and as screen shots, for purposes connected with the Competition, and you hereby irrevocably waive, for the benefit of the promoters, all moral rights in the entry to which you are entitled.
- b. The right to use your name, photograph and town or city of residence for the sole purpose of identifying you as the author of your entry and/or as a finalist or winner of the Competition.
- 9. Your entry must only feature you (and, if appropriate, other people aged 16 and over with their express permission), must be your own work, must not be copied, must not contain any third-party materials and/or content (including background music) that you do not have permission to use, must not promote your own or third party goods or services or include any trade marks (other than those belonging to the promoters), and must not show inappropriate or dangerous behaviour, or otherwise be obscene, defamatory, distasteful, offensive, or in breach of any applicable legislation or regulations, or in breach of any confidentiality obligations owed by you to third parties. If we have reason to believe your entry is not your own work, if a person objects to the inclusion of a video in which they are featured being included in the Competition, or if your entry otherwise breaches this paragraph, then we may not consider it and may disqualify it.

We may also disqualify your entry if you do not meet the entry criteria, you are not eligible to enter the Competition, you cannot be contacted or you do not respond within 5 days of being contacted by us in relation to your entry. In the event of disqualification, we may select a new longlisted entry, runner up or winner in accordance with the selection processes.

## Picking the runners up and winner

11. A panel of judges will choose entries from all the valid Competition entries using the criteria. The promoters will notify the entrants within one week of that date and request verification of their eligibility to enter the competition.
